No. P. 34 (9) C. I. (D) 33. The Government has been pleased to announce the following Cotton ginning and pressing rates for the season 1961-62.

Ginning Rate.	Rs. 1/8/- per Batta of 1000 lbs. of Kapas.
Pressing Rate.	Rs. 11/- per bale, subject to the condition that in case out on a flat opened, cupen one shall be charged extra.
Re-pressing Rate.	Rs. 5/8/- per bale, subject to the condition that if new baling hoops and headband are required their cost shall be charged extra.

The above rates shall be applicable uniformly to all Cotton ginning and pressing factories throughout Rajasthan, irrespective of the fact whether they belong to the Government or not, except that if these rates are fixed by virtue of the terms of an agreement between the Government of a Covenanting State concerned and a particular factory, the rates so fixed shall apply in respect of that factory and that the rates mentioned above, so long as the said terms are not modified or cancelled.
