No. P. 24 (8) C.I. (D) 52. The Government has been pleased to sanction the following Cotton ginning and pressing rates for the season 1951-52.

Ginning Rate. Rs. 1/9/- per Beryali maund of Kapas.

Pressing Rate. Rs. 11/- per bale, subject to the condition that in case cotton is not opened, super one shall be charged extra.

Re-pressing Rate. Rs. 5/8/- per bale, subject to the condition that if new baling hoops and heslan are required their cost shall be charged extra.

The above rates shall be applicable uniformly to all Cotton ginning and pressing factories throughout Rajasthan, irrespective of the fact whether they belong to the Government or not, except that if these rates are fixed by virtue of the terms of an agreement between the Government of a Covenanting State concerned and a particular factory, the rates so fixed shall apply in respect of that factory and not the rates mentioned above, so long as the said terms are not modified or cancelled.
